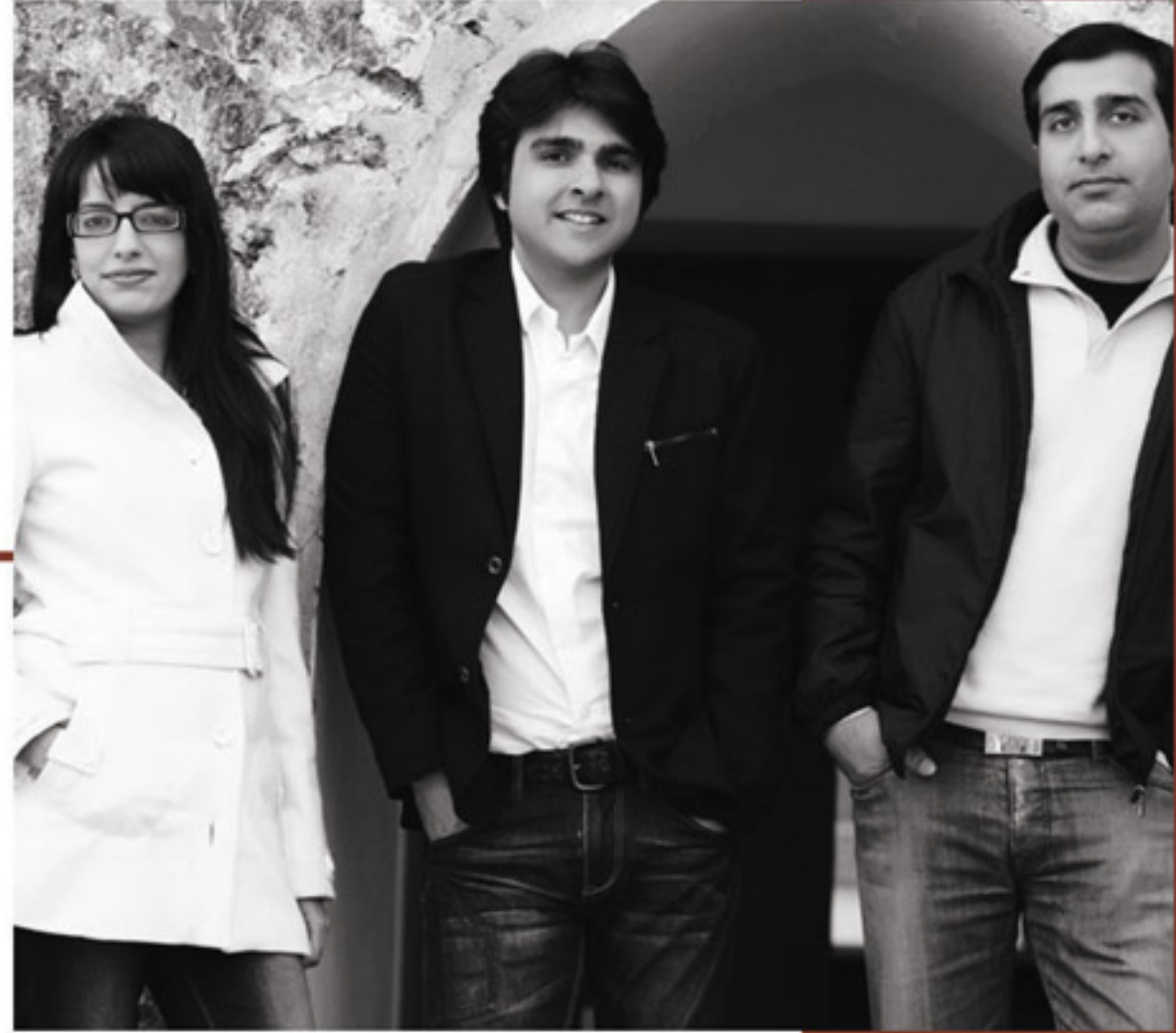

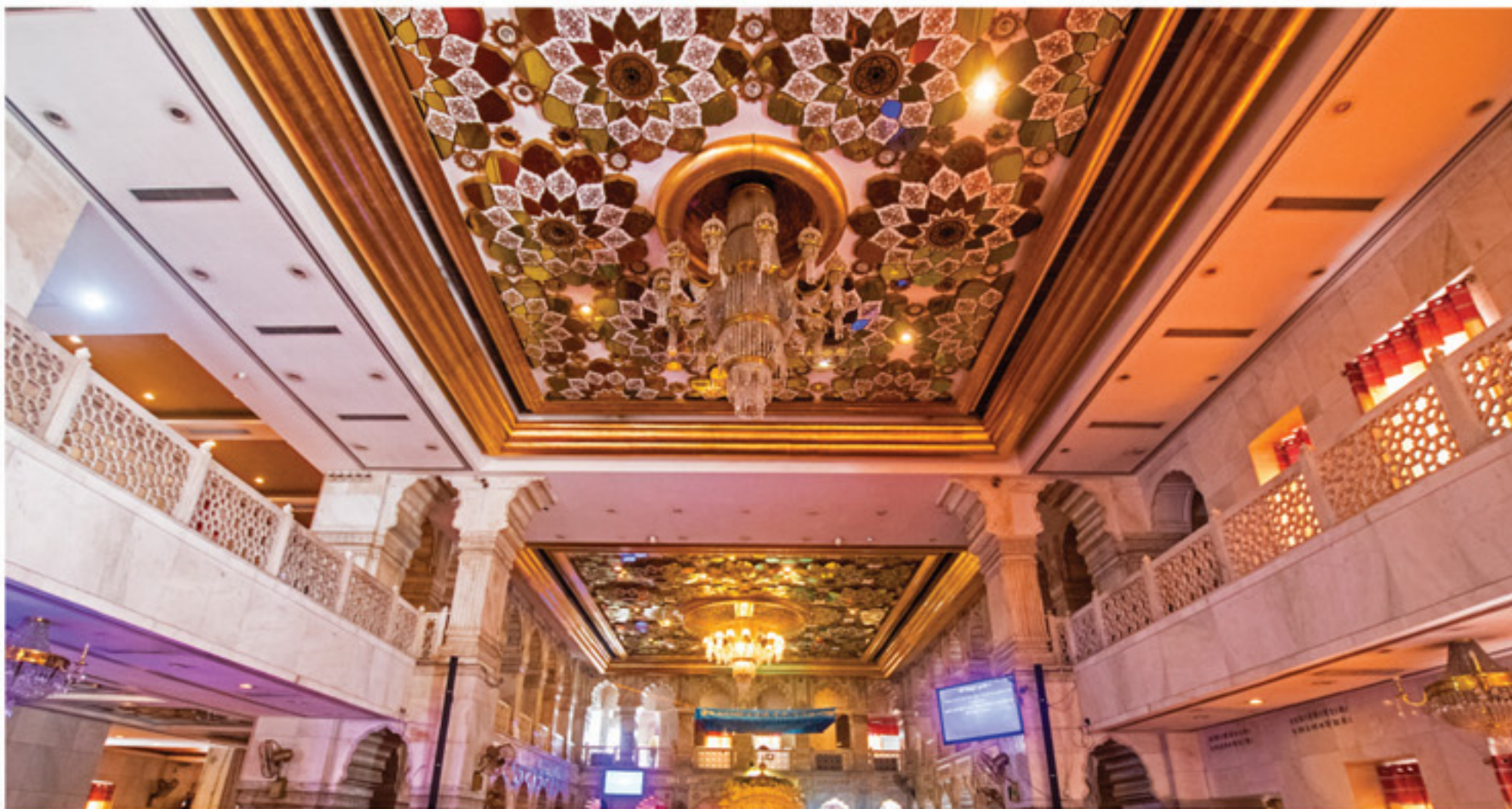

Sisganj Sahib Gurudwara Chandni Chowk

The SisGanj Sahib is one of the 9 iconic Gurudwaras of Delhi. It was built in 1783, and a new block added in 1970s. The new block was not in keeping with the historical context and the heritage architecture of the Sikhs.

CHALLENGES

Addition of Airconditioning, Modern day Sound and Video recording / Transmission systems.
Integration of the new hall with the historical context.
Structural intervention for suspension of VRV AC units and a service facility to maintain the indoor units without hampering the 24 hours functioning of the Gurdwara.
Addition of LED lighting. So as to have a maintenance free lighting solution.



DELIVERABLES

Mock structure created above roof level, to support the weight and vibration of outdoors AC units, and to suspend the indoor AC units, and a catwalk to service the same.
Structural scaffolding created to work on roof works while the 24- hours functioning of the Gurdwara continues as normal.
3- Dimensional flower ceiling concept created to house lights and AC grills integrated in finish and design in the ceiling.
Pulley system created to pull the the 'Chandoa Sahib' the heavily embroidered heavy fabric above the sanctum.
